WHEN DID YOU **FIRST DISCOVER** THAT YOU WERE PSYCHIC?

I had just completed my Reiki level two when I began to experience psychic impressions during treatments. Looking back, I realise I have been psychic most of my life, but I was tuned out, especially as I joined the forces at 17. Later, after moving to Wales, my next door neighbour introduced me to a weekly meditation and development group. When I started to listen to my feelings, trusted and learnt to follow the guidance, my life began to flow more easily. I stopped resisting it. My work took me into many healing and complementary health modalities as well as personal development.

WHAT ARE YOUR **PSYCHIC TALENTS**?

When I was in my early 40s, I went to a Diana Cooper workshop on Guardian Angels. This had a profound impact on me. I discovered my angel's name was Joseph, and started to develop a deeper connection. I later discovered how angel cards could help me tap in and obtain answers for friends. Eventually I took a recognised course. My psychic information, which primarily comes through clair-sentience and clair-cognitance, gives mental pictures and a knowingness about a situation or person.

Doreen Virtue in The Light Worker's Way describes psychics as having one or two channels in which they are naturally gifted. Receiving psychic impressions as pictures is clairvoyance. Clair-sentience is for those who get their information as hunches, emotions, smells and physical sensations. Those who are clairaudient receive psychic impressions as sounds or voices. Finally, people who are highly cognitive or thinking orientated are called clair-cognitant or clear thinking. They receive psychic information as complete ideas. They know information without knowing how they know.

WHAT **PSYCHIC TOOLS** DO YOU USE?

I enjoy working with individual clients to bring inspiration and assistance, especially in the area of career and life purpose. I have a variety of angel deck cards, and I intuitively connect to the voice of the caller



to know which oracles to use for individual situations or questions. I also call on my skills as an empathic energy healer and spiritual intuitive. I am passionate about being a channel of clear intent. I always set the intention for the best outcome of each caller to give them honest and appropriate answers. I believe we can change our energy and heal our situations. Occasionally, I offer simple tips and advice such as space clearing and flower essences which are vibrational energy, information in a reading. These useful tools are powerful for assisting simple positive changes to an individual's life.

Chris Martin



When interviewed by American radio personality Howard Stern about the inception of song *Yellow*, Chris Martin describes a process that was more intuitive than anything. He was uncertain about the line “they were all yellow” and didn’t know what it was supposed to mean. But it sounded right. “It was feeling more than a meaning,” he said.

It was less than four years from the time Chris Martin met his first bandmate, guitarist Jonny Buckland, to the time Coldplay released its debut album. But even if that album had been eight years in the making, or twenty years, Chris could not have been prepared for the rush of success to follow. When Parachutes hit shelves, people snatched it up. The album quickly went to number one in the UK and reached strong positions on charts around the globe, including the U.S. and Australia. Radio stations were particularly obsessed with *Yellow*, that signature song that came to Martin like a bolt from the blue.

But all the success in the world, including a seemingly storybook marriage to an A-list Hollywood actress, did not added up to a fairy tale ending for Chris Martin. He will be the first to tell you that life remains a challenge. But the music has endured, and Chris Martin remains one of the most celebrated frontmen in modern music history. Did all of this happen by accident? What spiritual energies were behind it?

As a Pisces in the Chinese Year of the Snake (2nd March, 1977), Chris had a double-dose of intuitive power from the start. Pisces is known as the watery, inward-turning sign of the zodiac, while Snake is among the most intuitive animals in Chinese lore. Pisces and Snake are a potent combination for an artist, since the best creative work bubbles up from a deep and mysterious place. Martin also had a music teacher for a mother, which gave him early and constant exposure to music, and to the nuts and bolts of how it gets made.

But Chris wasn’t a musical prodigy. His early years were not characterised by any thundering certainty that being a musician was the only life for him. Even if his deeper self knew what was coming, he would have felt the need for a deeper context and understanding of the world before sharing his talents. After attending a prep school, Chris enrolled in University College London. His areas of focus were Greek, Latin, and Ancient World Studies—suitable for the Snake, which is always hungry for knowledge and willing to undertake difficult scholarly tasks.

Lo and behold, when we look for Chris’s natal moon placement—arguably the second most important astrological component in Western astrology—we find it in Leo. This star studded sign loves the stage, and endows its natives with an electric presence. Chris’s Leo moon shows that he derives a very deep and emotional satisfaction from the adoration of audiences, and explains why he seems to love performing so much. The power to move audiences with his voice ignites a fire deep in his soul, but it’s more than ego or narcissism. Emotional connection is what Pisces and Snake is all about, and when Chris Martin stands before an audience, he seeks to establish a heartfelt connection to everyone in the room. That’s a big part of the reason why people love Coldplay. The songs come from a romantic and sensitive place, yet retain a clear power and strength that gets through to audiences who have seemingly heard it all before.

Both Snake and Pisces often prefer a quieter approach to life. Obviously, Chris Martin chose to give his Leo moon credence in this respect. But he’s still a Pisces, and prone to burnout and excessive levels of stress. Indeed, as the pressure mounted on Coldplay, Chris admits that drugs and drink found their way into the picture. The highly-publicised divorce from Gwyneth Paltrow is also something he still struggles with, according to recent interviews. But Chris Martin represents an incredible combination of emotional and worldly energies. He will always find a way to transform his troubles into musical moments that capture hearts around the world.

Psychic Spring Cleaning



New Year's resolutions are made in the cold of winter, and are often lost in the shuffle. GEMSTONES OF MARCH

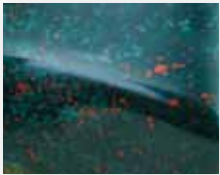
THERE ARE AT LEAST FIVE, EACH WITH ITS OWN HISTORY AND PSYCHIC POWERS.

Jade



If we turn our attention to ancient Tibet, we find another birthstone for March: The distinct and mystical green Jade. The properties of this stone are widely known and revered. In ancient China, Jade was among the most beneficial and fortunate gemstones to be found on earth, and it had various spiritual powers depending on the nature of the carving and the context of use. Even today, Jade is seen as a powerful gemstone in China. Many other ancient cultures used Jade to communicate with the spirit world and interpret dreams. It's also considered a powerful amulet for long life and relationships that endure.

Bloodstone



Before Aquamarine became the official March birthstone, the honour belonged to Bloodstone (also called heliotrope). A whole litany of cultures, from Hindu to Hebrew, recognized Bloodstone as the special stone of March. With its stunning green surface offset by flecks of red, it was said to have mystical benefits of strength and courage. It could ground and protect its bearer in difficult situations. As such, it was favored by ancient warriors and athletic performers. Bloodstone was closely associated with the sign of Aries, which of course begins in late March and has close ties to Mars, fire, and the removal of obstacles.

Jasper



Jasper is another gemstone associated with March, and it has an interesting relationship to Bloodstone. The flecks of red in Bloodstone are often composed of Jasper, while the psychic qualities of Jasper are much less "war-like." This is a stone with a very calming and relaxing vibration. Many specimens resemble impressionist nature paintings, and spirit guardians can sometimes be seen in pieces of Jasper. For relaxation and nurturing, it's an excellent stone. It also has distinct properties of good luck, and was used by certain Native American tribes during rainmaking rituals.

Gold Siva Linga



If you want the traditional Hindu birthstone for March, you'll need to get your hands on a Gold Siva Linga. A linga or lingam is a psychically powerful phallic symbol used to worship the god Shiva. In this case, it's not actually gold, but a variety of Jasper with a fleshy or golden color, and streaks of brown. This is a naturally shaped object, never cut or carved, and it's never worn as jewelry but rather used as an idol for ritual worship. But if you're up for bringing a Gold Siva Linga into your life, it can certainly activate powerful psychic channels with deep roots in ancient India.

Aquamarine



Aquamarine is the most mainstream March birthstone, having replaced Bloodstone in the 1950s. It's deeply Piscean in nature, embodying the very nature and spirit of the sea. The ancients believed that Aquamarine was a treasure guarded by mermaids. As such, it brought good luck and protection to sailors and people undertaking long journeys by sea. The name is derived from a Latin phrase, aqua marinus, which means sea water. This is truly a powerful stone for opening psychic channels, or simply making a relationship more transparent. Like the sea itself, Aquamarine also has close energetic ties to the moon.
